Understanding the World

The children will have the opportunity to look after a plant at home. Keep it in a place with plenty of sun light and water daily. Make a prediction about what you think will happen and then record your observations by drawing pictures of the plant at different stages of growth.



Expressive Arts & Design

In the story of Sleeping Beauty, the evil fairy turns into a big dragon. Make your own dragon using different materials. You can use paper plates, egg boxes or paper chains. How scary can you make your dragon?



Maths

Measure: Measure your plant ever week, how much did it grow?

Shape: We are going to learn about a range of 3-D shapes, can you find as many 3-D shapes as you can around your house. You can take pictures of them or draw them in your books.

3D shapes: cube, cylinder, cuboid, cone, sphere.



Number: We are learning to double and half numbers. What things can you double?

If you have 3 sweets and you double it, how many sweets do you have? **(3+3=6)**
