

Are you a good neighbour?

Residents, including the local churches, have been voicing their concerns about parking at drop off and pick up times.

Please can parents/ carers consider where parking vehicles as you may be parking on private land, blocking driveways and causing danger to children and adults in the area.

Please be aware that the Good Shepherd car park should not be used for parking on, unless using the premises, as it is private land. Driveways that are marked with a 'H bar' (see image below) along cannot be parked on by law, please keep these areas clear. Staff and parents have also shown their concern with parents that have been seen to be stopping their cars in the middle of the road and allowing children to walk into the road to enter cars. This is extremely dangerous for

the children and other road users and could result in serious injuries. Please allow plenty of time when dropping off and collecting children to prevent any of these problems for reoccurring.
